*Notes* : This is a manuscript copy of the ship's AAC opened at Melbourne and handed to the master just before departure from that port. Hence this version does not contain voyage completion data unless subsequently transcribed from the ship's AAC. Copy AACs were printed in red, and retained by the authorities until they received the ship's AAC which had to be handed in on termination of the agreement. Masters faced heavy financial penalties for failing to comply with the AAC regulations, potentially totalling in excess of £50. This copy AAC is all in the same hand for lines 1 to 12, where as on the ship's AAC except for illiterates, seamen's own signatures would be found. Interpretation of names thus depends on the transcriber's interpretation of signatures. Lines 13 to 16 have been added from port entry and departure crew listing which was demanded in addition to sighting the ship's AAC. However the signatures at lines 13 to 15 being all different, may be genuine. The ship's AAC would have collected additional entries with crew turnover and official certification at ports of call during the voyage, and at final discharge in an Australian port when the AAC was terminated. In the UK the red copy AACs were destroyed on receipt of the terminated ship's AACs. [\*] There is no discharge data on this AAC for these crew members. Discharge data is from HvM cards, source unknown. Andersen data has been added from an HvM card.[+] named in "Inward list of Crew" from Melbourne to Sydney date 11 July 1888. There are no shipping master or consular office certificate entries, rubber stamps marks or payment stamps on this copy AAC.
